



COSTUME IDEAS

BASIC ONE SHOULDER ROBE PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

This pattern will fit a small to medium man. To make smaller or larger, adjust the size of the arm hole and the length and width of the robe. Take a measurement over the clothes at the widest part, (tummy or hips) and add 10 to 12 inches for ease. This will allow for freedom of movement and also accommodate any clothing, jacket etc worn under.

1. Cut one piece on the fold OR 2 pieces according to your measurements. These will be the front and back pieces
2. Sew the shoulder seams together
3. Sew the side seam (both sides if not cut on the fold)
4. Finish the seams of the arm hole
5. Finish the diagonal edge that goes across the chest.
6. Finish the bottom hem with your choice of edging, a straight seam, cut a square shaped edge as shown on the pattern, or any other way you wish.
7. Sew a long rectangular strip for the belt to bring in the waist of the robe
8. A matching or coordinating t-shirt should be worn underneath




MORONI'S QUEST COSTUME IDEAS

- Tunic
- Sash for waist
- Satchel for carrying scriptures, etc.
- Square piece of fabric for head covering with sash to tie it to your head
- Shorts to wear under tunic
- Optional long vest or open jacket for overlay



Variations to the basic robe pattern.





Basic Pattern for Satchel

It should hold your Book of Mormon, a water bottle, your Liahona Book (you'll receive at quest) and a pencil. The strap is long enough to cross your body hanging on one shoulder.





Sew end to end together A to A.

Turn and press the seam inside - the bag will be double fabric. Center seam to middle of fabric. Fold fabric in half along this seam. Sew the side seams together - both thicknesses B to B.


On the inside flatten the corner seam to seam and sew across it 2". Repeat on the other side.




36" Turn right side out.

Sew sides of strap together. Turn & press.

B fold raw edge of strap under and stitch down 5" of the side of the bag. Repeat on the other side.



To hold the top of the bag together use Velcro.
