

## **Moroni's Quest 2026 Leader requirements:**

We are excited to have your Ward participate in this special Youth Conference. We anticipate this will be a great spiritual feast and meaningful lifetime experience for those who attend. We appreciate all the work you do regularly with the youth in your Ward and hope this will further strengthen your relationship with each young woman and young man. We support your endeavors to bring the youth unto Christ as they develop a greater love and testimony of His gospel.

We have some very specific requirements for bishoprics and the ward YW leaders:

### **Re-enactments?**

Each ward will be assigned 2-3 re-enactments that they will be responsible for performing at Moroni's Quest. Please try to involve as many of your youth as possible. Youth leaders that are already attending may also fill some roles. There will likely not be parts for every youth but hopefully you can be creative and use some as extras in the scene. Please don't force youth that are opposed to performing. We want this to be a positive experience. We have a re-enactment director assigned to each ward to be used as a resource should you need some help with directing.

Elaine Leishman is heading our costume committee and will work with your ward to find costumes for your assigned re-enactment. Because the youth will already be wearing tunics we may only need to add accessories to differentiate their roles to keep things simplified. For the bigger roles we will have more elaborate costumes. Feel free to use youth activity nights to practice your re-enactments. President Low has requested that the youth learn their lines. If that becomes too difficult, we always have the option of voice recordings. As MQ approaches we will provide a deadline as to when lines need to be learned by.

We will be scheduling a Sunday to go through all the scenes at the Stake Centre and a site visit rehearsal on June 20th. Not everyone may be able to attend but hopefully we can get most of your cast to come as it is helpful for them to get a sense of the space they will be performing in.

We know we are asking a great deal of youth leaders for this event. It is a huge group effort that will yield great spiritual rewards for our youth which they greatly need during these difficult times.

### **Who should attend?**

All youth turning 14 in 2026 to 18 years, are eligible to attend. We ask that the Bishops and one councillor, and the YW President and one councillor attend. Depending on the number of youth it may be necessary for additional leaders to attend. We need one leader for every 5 youth attending.

### **Dress/Costumes?**

Each youth/adult will need 2 costumes for Moroni's Quest. They will also need a satchel that they can carry with them for the entire time. This satchel needs to be large enough to carry a Book of Mormon, small journal, pens and water bottle. A combined ward youth activity may be arranged in your ward to make the satchels and tunics. Please see the handouts in this binder, or visit the website for additional ideas and details about the costumes and satchels. We ask that ward leaders follow up with youth to ensure that everyone has the clothing and satchel ready for Quest.

### **Daytime Responsibilities for Youth Leaders?**

During the day, youth leaders may be assigned to help with various duties or participate in re-enactments as actors. Youth leaders and Bishoprics will also be part of adult tribes during the day. Adult tribes will do all that the youth tribes do. This will provide opportunities for youth leaders to experience the same things the youth do, allowing better continuation of experiences in the months afterwards.

### **Meals?**

ALL meals will be provided by the stake. There will be plenty of food. We will eat all meals in a common area.

### **Evening Responsibilities for Youth Leaders?**

Your main responsibilities are in the evening and at night. The youth will be with the tribe leaders during the day in tribes of up to 12 youth. At night all the youth will return to their ward camps. YM will be in one area and YW in another. Each ward will be assigned a camping area that will be used only for sleeping. The adult ward leaders will be responsible for supervision of their ward youth in their ward camp. Sleeping assignments will be left to ward leaders. Tents need to be provided by the ward.

### **Fireside/Activity?**

Thursday Night: On Thursday night we would like youth leaders to have a fun activity planned for your youth. Plan for the activity to last about 2 hours.

Friday Night: Bishops will need to plan a fireside for their youth. It is recommended that a testimony meeting be incorporated into this fireside. Plan for approximately 2 hours.

Firepits and firewood will be provided. Treats will be delivered on both evenings to be enjoyed around the campfire.

There are activities planned for before and after both of these evenings.

### **Transportation of Youth and Gear?**

You are asked to assist in transporting youth, leaders and their gear to the Moroni's Quest Site. Maps are included in this binder or refer to the website for instructions. Please contact Tiffany Hill if you need a PIN.

## **What happens when we arrive?**

Youth and leaders should arrive in their Moroni's Quest costumes and with their satchel and water bottle. Once you arrive on site your gear will be transported to your ward camp site. You will not have access to your gear until later that day when you set up camp. **All gear needs to be clearly labelled with your name, ward and designated either for the Young Men or Young Women's campsites.**

## **Registration?**

The registration process for Moroni's Quest will be made available on our website after the March 15th opening fireside. Please encourage youth and leaders to register early to allow for planning. All adults attending must also register on the website.

## **Release/Consent Form?**

We will be collecting signed medical release forms for each youth. A copy is included in this binder.

## **Discipline?**

It is not anticipated that we will have many discipline problems but in the event that a youth needs to be talked to, it will be the responsibility of the ward leaders initially and then if needed the parents may be contacted.

## **Security of Camp?**

Each Ward is responsible for the security of their individual campsites. Youth will not be allowed into the girls or boys campsites without a ward leader chaperone. No unsupervised wandering allowed. Youth to stay in Tribes or Ward groups at all times. Please use your best judgement. If youth need special assistance during the day, Ward leaders (not Tribe leaders) will be responsible.

## **Book of Mormon reading schedule?**

Please help prepare for Moroni's Quest by encouraging your youth to read the Book of Mormon. The youth will be receiving a read schedule ahead of time and some are included in this binder.
